ACTION CLOCK: The Action Clock by Protection Poker will be used once the field is down to one (1) table out of the money. Remaining players will have thirty (30) seconds to act on their hand. To begin play in the Action Clock portion of the tournament, each player will receive time-extension chips, each worth a 30-second addition to a player's action. In the case that time expires for a player with remaining time extension chips, the player's Action Clock will automatically extend an additional thirty (30) seconds. Collection of time extension chips will take place at the end of the player's action. If a player's Action Clock expires and the player does not have any time-extension chips remaining, the player will be (a) forced to check, if there is no bet pending or (b) fold, if facing a bet or raise. See WPT Action Clock Rules for more details.

ANTE FORMAT: Single ante will be posted by the player in the big blind, in the amount equivalent to the big blind. Ante is posted before the big blind and players are eligible to collect the entire ante, even when out of the big blind. Ante is maintained until the completion of the tournament.

BREAKS: Players will have a 15-minute break every two levels on Day 1A/B and a 90-minute dinner break after Level 6. Players will have a 15-minute break every two levels on Day 2 and a 60-minute dinner break after Level 16. Players will have a break after every level on Day 3 and Day 4.

BUY-IN & FEES: \$3,200 entry fee will be used to fund the prize pool. \$300 is a registration fee of which \$100 will go towards staffing.

FINAL TABLE: Final table of the final six (6) players will be filmed for television at PokerGo Studio in Las Vegas. *Due to the WPT Seminole Hard Rock Poker Showdown TV Final Table being played in Las Vegas, Nevada, where the minimum gambling age is 21, all participants must be 21 or over to play the Championship or related satellites.*

LATE REGISTRATION: Alternates and late sign-ups will enter the tournament with a full chip stack.

LEVELS, PER DAY: Day 1A/B will end after Level 10. Day 2 will end after Level 20. Day 3 will play five, 90-minute levels. Day 4 will play down to six players. TV Final Table (six remaining players) will play 60-minute levels until heads-up, then levels become 30 minutes in length.

PAYOUTS: One in eight entries will be in the money (approximately 12.5%).

PLAYER'S CARD and PLAYER RELEASE: In order to play in the event, each player must have a Seminole Hard Rock Casino player's card and sign the mandatory WPT Player Release Form. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding.

PLAYERS PER TABLE: 8-handed play and the televised final table will consist of the final 6 players.

RE-ENTRY RULES: Single re-entry per day is available until the start of Level 9.

REGISTRATION: Players may register for Day 1A, and/or Day 1B. If player entered into any starting day and was eliminated from tournament, player may re-enter or register for subsequent starting day(s). Players may not bag and play a subsequent flight. Players may forfeit their stack to re-enter or participate in subsequent starting day.

RULES: Any unauthorized chips introduced into tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution. Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction of said chips will be disqualified without refund. It's each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention unusual chips, circumstances, and/or irregularities. Tournament Directors Association (TDA) rules apply to this tournament.

SEATING REDRAWS: A redraw will occur at the end of Day 1 and Day 2. There will also be redraws at 24, 16, and 8 players (or at Tournament Director's discretion). Before the redraw at 8 players to one table, the two remaining tables will be 5-handed and 4-handed.

TOURNAMENT TICKETS: Are non-refundable and non-transferable.
