RULES & INFORMATION

ANTE FORMAT (BIG BLIND ANTE): Single ante will be posted by the player in the big blind, in the amount equivalent to the big blind. Ante is posted before the big blind and players are eligible to collect the entire ante, even when out of the big blind. Ante is maintained until the completion of the tournament.

BREAKS: Days 1A / 1B / 2: Days 1A / 1B / 2: Players will have 15 minutes for every 3 levels, and a 60-minute dinner break after Level 9 on Day1A & B and Level 27 on Day 2.
Final Table: breaks are TBD

BUY-IN & FEES: \$1,100 total buy-in = \$1,000 + \$100 Note: Three percent (3%) of the prize pool will be withheld for tournament staff fees.

LATE REGISTRATION: Registration closes at the start of Level 10, approximately 7:30 p.m. on Day 1A & B.

LEVELS, PER DAY: 40-Minute per level

Day 1A / 1B: Fifteen (15) levels
Day 2: Play down to final table of eight (8); May change per Tournament Director's discretion
Final Table: Play down to winner

PAYOUTS: One in eight (1-in-8) entries will be in the money (approximately 12.5%). Winners may choose to be paid in casino chips or cash. Winners must show valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042s forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).

PLAYER'S CARD and PLAYER RELEASE: In order to play in the event, each player must have Choctaw Player Card and sign the WPT Player Release Form. Must be 21 years of age or older to play.

PLAYERS PER TABLE: Tables will begin 9-handed and move to 8-handed when 10 tables remain.

REENTRY RULES: Unlimited re-entry is allowed until the start of Level 10, when registration ends. This is not a best-stack forward event. Players may forfeit their stack to re-enter, if registration is still open.

RULES: : Tournament Directors Association (TDA) rules will be used, unless House Rules apply. Please, see Choctaw tournament staff for House Rules. Additionally, on the money bubble, play will be round-for-round, instead of hand-for-hand. Participation in WPT tournaments is subject to rules and rulings set forth by the applicable venue(s) and/or WPT (e.g., tournament rules, sponsors).

SEATING REDRAWS: Day 2, 27 and Final Table.

STARTING STACK: 30,000 tournament chips. Pre-purchased stacks will be "live" on the table from the beginning of the tournament. Late registrants and alternates will be sold a full starting stack.

WPTDEEPSTACKS NORTH AMERICA CHAMPIONSHIP: Three thousand dollars (\$3,000) will be withheld from the total prize pool and awarded to the first place finisher at the conclusion of this event with any other prize money awarded.

WPTDEEPSTACKS NORTH AMERICA PLAYER OF THE YEAR: The Main Event is eligible for WPTDeepStacks Player of the Year Leaderboard.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL: Players shall have no recourse following the beginning of the next hand. The next hand begins at the start of first significant action.
