# Wynn Summer Classic Poker Series General Terms and Conditions 

## May 25-July 19, 2023

1. These General Poker Tournament Terms and Conditions are meant to be read and followed in conjunction with Wynn's standard poker tournament rules, and each individual Tournament event's (may be referred to as "Event" or collectively as a "Tournament") Terms and Conditions and Structure Sheet. In the event there is a conflict, these Terms and Conditions shall prevail.
2. Players and guests must be at least 21 years of age.
3. Registration for each Event will open four (4) hours prior to the scheduled start of play. Players will register in the Wynn Las Vegas Poker Room, located in Encore at Wynn Las Vegas.
4. The Tournament entry fee (the "Entry Fee") must be paid with cash or Wynn Las Vegas live casino chips; no other forms of payment will be accepted.
5. All Events will use Tournament chips for play. Tournament chips have no cash value, may not be used for any other purpose, and must be returned to Wynn Las Vegas at the end of each Event.
6. All Events will utilize the Big Blind Ante format unless otherwise noted on the Tournament structure sheet. In the event that the player in the big blind has less than the required amount to post both the big blind and the ante, the ante will be posted first. The big blind will then be posted with any remaining Tournament chips.
7. Tournament chip stacks will be put into play at the start of the event for all registered players who have been issued a table and seat assignment. Players registered as an "alternate" will receive a seat assignment from the Tournament Staff when seating becomes available.
8. At the conclusion of the registration period, all paid entries (including alternates) who have yet to be seated will be assigned a seat and their Tournament chips will be put into play.
9. A player will forfeit their option to cancel (void) their entry once their Tournament chip stack has been put into play and will not be entitled to a refund.
10. Winners will be paid in Wynn Las Vegas live casino chips.
11. Players will need to refer to each Event's structure sheet for applicable details including but not limited to the scheduled dates of play, start times, and other relevant structure information.
12. IRS Compliance requires each player provide a valid government issued ID and a social security number. Nonresident aliens are subject to $30 \%$ US Income Tax withholding. ITIN's are required for Treaty Country exemptions. Tax form W-2G will be issued to all players winning in excess of $\$ 5,000$, net of the applicable Tournament Entry Fee.
13. Wynn Las Vegas standard poker tournament rules (found at wynnpoker.com and inside the Wynn Poker Room) and current standard TDA rules (found at https://www.pokertda.com/poker-tda-rules/) apply.
14. While players are required to be a member of the Wynn Rewards program in order to participate in a Tournament, Wynn Rewards has its own separate and distinct terms and conditions. Please visit the Wynn Rewards desk for details.
15. Players and guests will be required to adhere to all applicable Wynn Las Vegas policies. Wynn Resorts requires appropriate and respectful interactions between our guests and employees in our resorts. Wynn Resorts reserves the right to trespass anyone exhibiting behavior, language or clothing that, at our discretion, is inconsistent with the Wynn Resorts behavior standards. The Wynn behavior standards and other applicable policies can be accessed at www.wynnlasvegas.com. In the event a player or their guests are prevented from accessing property as a result of such policies or trespassed from property for non-compliance with such
policies, then player shall be prohibited from participating in the Event or Tournament series and will not be entitled to any prizes or gifts associated with the Event or Tournament series.
16. Wynn Las Vegas reserves the right to refuse entry to, or disqualify, any individual at any time before or during the Event or Tournament series for any reason in Wynn Las Vegas' sole discretion.
17. Players who are unable to participate or are disqualified from an Event are not entitled to any refunds or payouts.
18. A risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place or accommodation. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can cause severe illness and death. By visiting Wynn Las Vegas, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.
19. Wynn Las Vegas management reserves the right to revise, suspend, or cancel events at its sole discretion, without prior notice or liability.
20. The Tournament series and these Terms and Conditions are subject to Nevada Revised Statutes 463.362-463.3668 and Nevada Gaming Commission Regulation 7A and subject thereto, all decisions made by Wynn Las Vegas, which shall be deemed final.
21. Prior to the start of the Tournament, players may be required to execute a Film, Videotape, and/or Photograph Release as a condition of participating in the Tournament. If a player fails to execute a Film, Videotape, and/or Photograph Release, Wynn reserves the right to refuse entry to such individual.
22. Participants are prohibited from using gaming charts or any other poker training tool while in the Tournament area. Any participant found with gaming charts or any other poker training tool while in the Tournament area may be penalized in Wynn Las Vegas' sole discretion, up to and including disqualification.
23. Filming or streaming of live action or hole cards is prohibited. Any participant found to be in violation may be penalized in Wynn Las Vegas' sole discretion, up to and including disqualification.

## Tournament Action Clock General Terms and Conditions

1. Each player will have fifteen (15) seconds to initially act on their hand preflop.
2. Once a player has voluntarily placed chips into the pot, the Tournament Action Clock will increase to thirty (30) seconds for each subsequent action of that player until the hand has concluded.
3. The small and big blind are forced bets and are not considered voluntary.
4. When the remaining players of the event are "in the money", each player will have twenty (20) seconds to initially act on their hand preflop. All subsequent action of that player will remain at thirty (30) seconds per action.
5. When the event reaches six (6) players remaining, each action (including preflop) for all players remaining will be thirty (30) seconds.
6. Each player will receive ten (10) 30-second time extensions "chips".
7. When the event reaches twenty-four (24) players remaining, each player will replenish up to six (6) time extension "chips". Players above six (6) time extensions will retain their "extra" unused time and the extra "chips" will not be reduced.
8. When the event reaches 6 players remaining, each player will replenish up to six (6) time extension "chips". Players above six (6) time extensions will retain their "extra" unused time and the extra "chips" will not be reduced.
9. Should an event reach 24 players prior to the close of registration, the six (6) time extensions will be replenished at the beginning of the level that follows the close of registration.
10. Time extensions will only be replenished when the tournament reaches 24 and 6 players remaining.
11. Dealers will initiate the start of the clock upon the completion of the deal. Time will begin for a player once the natural flow of play has come to a brief pause pending their action. Time will be reset for each player.
12. When a bet or raise has been made, the dealer will count and announce the bet or raise (including All In bets) prior to starting the Tournament Action Clock for the next player.
13. To facilitate the smooth operation of the tournament, all tournament chips must remain in full stacks of twenty (20) chips when available.
14. When breaking a table, players will transport their time extensions, along with their tournament chips and in plain view, with them to their new seat.
15. Should a tournament day conclude during the Action Clock period of play, yet before a period in which time extensions are scheduled to be replenished, any unused time extensions will be placed in the players' tournament chip bag and carry over to the next tournament day. Time extensions are to be treated with the same level of importance as tournament chips, and removal of time extensions may be subject to penalty up to and including disqualification.
16. The Tournament Action Clock will NOT be suspended unless an extreme situation arises in which play will be halted.
17. During tournament play, players are required to keep all time extension chips visible and on the table at all times.
18. Players will automatically lose one (1) time extension each time the Tournament Action Clock reaches zero ( 0 ) and will be instructed by the dealer to turn in the corresponding amount of time extensions used at the completion of their action. Players are not responsible for placing a time extension into the pot in real time.
19. In the event that a player does not have any remaining time extensions and their Tournament Action Clock reaches zero (0), the player's hand will be declared dead.

This $\$ 10,500$ NLH $\$ 10,000,000$ Guarantee poker tournament (the "Tournament") is a four-day No Limit Hold'em event.

Day 1B: Monday, July 10, 2023 at 12 p.m.
Day 1C: Tuesday, July 11, 2023 at 12 p.m.
Day 2: Wednesday, July 12, 2023 at 12 p.m.

## Registration:

One (1) Entry and One (1) re-entry for each starting flight will be available until the start of level 9 (approximately $9: 45$ p.m.). A player who advances to Day 2 is prohibited from entering a subsequent starting flight. A player that has advanced to Day 2 who enters a starting flight in error will be disqualified from the subsequent flight and will not be entitled to a refund of their Tournament re-entry fee. The player will be permitted to play Day 2 with their Tournament chip stack from the original starting flight.

## Starting Stack:

Players will start with 40,000 in tournament chips.
