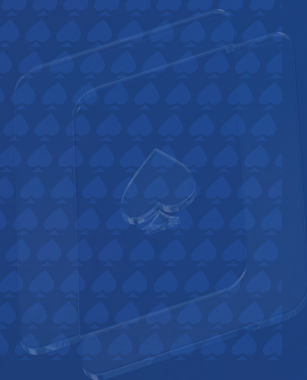

WORLD POKER TOUR® SEASON XXII FIRST HALF SCHEDULE SET TO TRAVERSE THE GLOBE

Irvine, CA (October 19, 2023) – The World Poker Tour® has locked in the first half of the Season XXII schedule, offering an eclectic combination of seven WPT® Prime and four WPT Main Tour festivals across the globe from late January to early June.

“As we approach the end of Season XXI and the WPT World Championship, we are proud to share the schedule for the first half of Season XXII,” said WPT CEO Adam Pliska. “

We worked vigorously with our casino partners to solidify dates for these impressive, value-packed festivals so that players may plan their 2024 schedules.”

Kicking off Season XXII is Main Tour stop WPT Cambodia at NagaWorld in Phnom Penh with the festival running Jan. 17-30 and the Championship event going Jan. 25-29. Second up on the Main Tour is the return of WPT Rolling Thunder at Thunder Valley Casino Resort in Northern California with festival dates spanning March 7-26, and the \$3,500 Championship event starting March 23.

Two more Main Tour festivals take place back-to-back in April and May. First, the WPT Seminole Hard Rock Poker Showdown festival runs from April 3-23. Drawing 2,290 entries in the \$3,500 Championship event this year, Seminole Hard Rock Hollywood now lays claim to nine of the top ten largest fields in WPT history.

Rounding out the first half of the Main Tour calendar is WPT Choctaw. The Oklahoma stop returns for its ninth installment and features a \$3,800 Championship event among the festival schedule of April 17-May 6.

The Prime Tour begins with WPT Prime Aix-en-Provence with festival dates of Jan. 26-Feb. 5, followed by the WPT Prime Amsterdam festival from March 15-23.

At the tail end of March, the first-ever WPT Voyage makes way. Virgin Voyages’ 1,400-cabin Valiant Lady will set sail from Miami on March 31 and return to port on April 6. Both a Prime title and Main Tour title will be awarded during the flagship event.

April features another pair of Prime stops. Card Casino Bratislava hosts WPT Prime Slovakia for the second time, putting on a festival from April 5-15. Then, WPT Prime Gold Coast returns at The Star Gold Coast for a third-consecutive year from April 10-23, subject to regulator approval.

Also returning for a third-consecutive year is WPT Prime Vietnam. A festival at the Crown Poker Club in Hanoi is set for May 14-27.

Finishing off the Season XXII first half schedule is the WPT Prime Sanremo from May 31-June 10 at Casinò di Sanremo.

PLAYER OF THE FESTIVAL WPT® WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP AT WYNN LAS VEGAS

WPT® Player of the Festival points are awarded based on two variables, the total prizepool of each eligible event and the buy-in category.

The buy-in categories include a number of buy-in brackets, for example USD \$500 to \$999, and separate categories for Prime Main Events & Main Tour Main Events.

The winner of the WPT® Player of the Festival award will be the player who earns the most POF points during the period comprising such WPT® Festival.

In the event of a tie on points, the following tiebreaking system will apply (only move to the next numbered tiebreaker if players tying are still equal):

- 1st tiebreaker – Most Titles
- 2nd tiebreaker – Most Final Tables*
- 3rd tiebreaker – Most In The Points
- 4th tiebreaker – Most \$ Won*

* Only applies to "results in the points"

4th tiebreaker notes – In the event a jurisdiction/casino allows deal making, then the individual cashes as listed by the venue will be shown on WPT® channels and distribution networks. If the jurisdiction/casino does not allow deal making, then individual cashes will be shown as per the official prizepool on WPT® channels and distribution networks.

To receive points as per the POF points schedule, a player must be In The Money.

Invitational, Teams and events with restrictions for age, sex or other reasons are not considered Eligible Events and thus will not count towards Player of the Festival Points.

Points for events such as Heads Up where for example, 4 players are eliminated from the last 8, will be averaged out according to the total of 5th to 8th place points.

Any tournament added after the commencement of the festival is not eligible for POF points.

In the event of a deal, WPT® reserves the right to revert POF points to the originally assigned totals (pre-deal) in the event that the deal unfairly alters a player's position in the POF standings.

PRIZES: The top 3 winners of the Promotion will receive WPT® Passport prize, to be used at the Passport Event

First Place – One (1) WPT® Passport valued at Ten Thousand Four Hundred U.S. Dollars (\$10,400 USD)

Second Place – One (1) WPT® Passport valued at Five Thousand U.S. Dollars (\$3,500 USD)

Third Place – One (1) WPT® Passport valued at One Thousand One Hundred U.S. Dollars (\$1,100 USD)

A player qualifying more than once In The Money in an Event will only receive points for his/her highest placing in that Event.

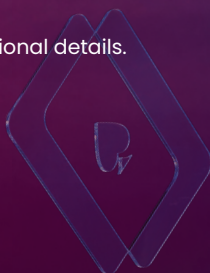

ACTION CLOCK

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Dealers will initiate the start of the Tournament Action Clock upon the completion of the deal. Time will begin for a player once the natural flow of play has come to a brief pause pending their action and be reset to the corresponding time for the next player to act.
2. Prior to the tournament being "in the money", players will have fifteen (15) seconds on their Action Clock preflop.
3. Once the tournament has reached "the money", players will have twenty (20) seconds on their Action Clock preflop.
4. Once the tournament has reached the final table, players will have thirty (30) seconds on their Action Clock preflop.
5. Once a player has voluntarily placed chips into the pot, the Tournament Action Clock will increase to thirty (30) seconds for each subsequent action of that player until the hand has concluded.
6. The small and big blind are forced bets and are not considered voluntary.
7. When a bet or raise has been made, the dealer will count and announce the bet or raise (including All In bets) prior to starting the Action Clock for the next player.
8. To facilitate the smooth operation of the tournament, all tournament chips must remain in full stacks of twenty (20) chips, when available.
9. When breaking a table, a player must keep their time extensions and tournament chips in plain view while traveling to their new seat.
10. Each time extension will add an additional thirty (30) seconds to act.
11. Players will receive time extension chips at predetermined stages (set level or remaining number of players) as outlined below for each specific event.
12. Players are required to keep all time extension chips visible and on the table at all times.
13. Players will automatically lose one (1) time extension each time the Action Clock reaches zero (0), and will be instructed by the dealer to turn in the corresponding amount of time extensions used at the completion of their action. Players are not responsible for placing a time extension chip into the pot in real time.
14. In the event that a player does not have any time extensions remaining and the Action Clock reached zero (0), the player's hand will be declared dead (or the player will be forced to check if facing no action).
15. Once implemented, the Tournament Action Clock will be used until the completion of the event and will not be suspended.
16. At the conclusion of play each day, any unused time extension chips will be placed in the players' tournament chip bag and will carry over to the next tournament day. Time extensions are to be treated with the same level of importance as tournament chips, and removal of time extensions may be subject to penalty up to and including disqualification.

QUALIFIER Q&A SESSION CLUBWPT™

On July 30, John Riesterer won a 400-player online poker tournament on ClubWPT with a first-place prize of a seat to the 2023 WPT World Championship at Wynn Las Vegas. ClubWPT, a free poker platform for players in the United States with several subscription tiers, will send more than 20 \$12,500 WPT Passport winners to December's \$40 million guaranteed WPT World Championship.

Riesterer, a 71-year-old Air Force veteran and retired real estate broker from Pulaski, Wisconsin, reflected upon his victory and his time playing on ClubWPT over the last decade.

John, how did you start playing on ClubWPT?

Well, I actually joined in 2011, after Black Friday. I started looking for an alternate site that allowed me to play in the United States, came across ClubWPT and began all the way back then.

So you've been playing quite a long time on ClubWPT. Can you talk about some of your highlights over the years?

I don't know if you're familiar with Dan Ross from Hold'em Radio. Dan, a few years back, used to stream the main tournament, and back then it was the VIP tournament on Sunday afternoons. I came across that at one point in time, and he had a regular community of players. And actually, there's quite a few of them that are still playing to this day.

Dan held tournaments as well. And every year there was the Tournament of Champions, TOC, and three years in a row, I won that. I actually won my poker table by playing with that group back then. But [eventually] that kind of fizzled out.

You couldn't ask for much better timing for a prize like that. As far as playing live poker goes, I believe you cashed in an MSPT event a few years back – do you get to play a lot outside of ClubWPT?

Well, I used to play live at our local casino up until COVID hit. I played in their tournaments when they held them, but since COVID hit, they shut that down. They've since come back with cash games, but no tournaments. I did play in that MSPT and took 23rd, and then another on that tour back in March of this year. But let's not talk about that one.

Like a lot of other people, you were part of a community that got together online during the pandemic and has stayed pretty close, right?

When COVID hit, they started doing the streams – Lynn Gilmartin, Vince Van Patten, Tony Dunst and Matt Savage, they were all starting to stream. Well, I started watching that, and then they started a Twitch stream team group, which I became part of. It's been quite the experience. It's a fun group. The stream team hangs together, and every night there's one of the streams when they play. It is quite a community, and I have had the good fortune.

You mentioned some past successes, but obviously that's all peaked this year. What was it like to actually win a \$12,500 WPT Passport to the WPT World Championship at Wynn Las Vegas?

Well, that was a blast of course. In order to win, it went in stages. You had to be in the top 20 in one of the tournaments, or they had two of them that were top 50 to qualify to get into the final. The final tournament was 400 players, and you had to win that in order to get that 12.5k package and that was actually streamed by Brad Braulio. So I had all the guys watching me do it, and it just went really, really well right up to the very end. I got good cards and they held, finally.

Well, bigger and better things coming for you in December. Have you thought about what it'll be like coming out to Las Vegas in December?

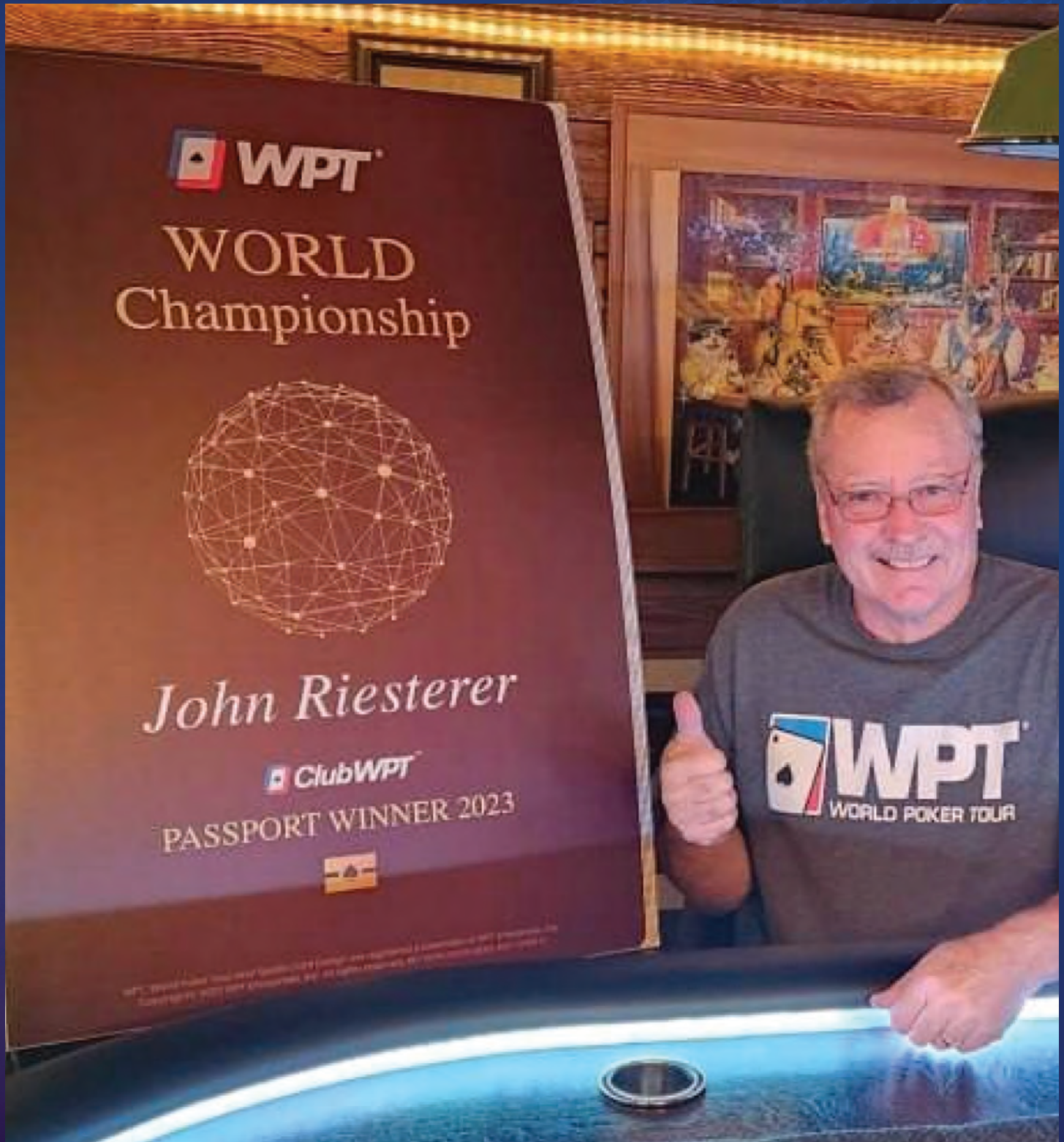
There's going to be more than just the big tournament out there. I asked my wife if she wanted to go along with me, and she hates flying, so she declined. Then I asked my son, who lives here in Wisconsin, and he accepted. We're going to fly out on the seventh of December and play the \$500 buy-in ClubWPT event (a \$50,000 guaranteed tournament with a free WPT Prime Championship seat for every final table participant who is a ClubWPT member). We're gonna give that a shot. My one son is joining me from the 7th to the 14th, and then my other son, who lives in Colorado, is flying in and staying from the 8th through the 11th. We're really looking forward to it, we don't get together too often and so this is going to be quite the experience in itself, the three of us.

Then there's going to be all the other stream teamers who are going to be out there and hopefully, Jeremy Clemons will get a stream team tournament put together like he did last year, too.

Sounds like a pretty strong plan. And then there's the WPT World Championship itself. What are your thoughts about playing a \$10,400 buy-in tournament of this magnitude?

I can't wait for it to happen. I played the WSOP Colossus back in 2015, so I've had the experience of thousands of players together, so I've got that part of it behind me. Of course, there'll be a lot of well-known players that are going to show up for a \$40 million guarantee. I expect to see a minimum of 4,000 players, and probably closer to 5 or 6,000, I think.

It is going to be a thrill of a lifetime. I never would have been able to do this without having won this opportunity through ClubWPT.
